

## Southport Reflects on 21-22 Year at Southport's 30<sup>th</sup> Annual General Meeting

Southport's 30<sup>th</sup> Annual General Meeting (AGM), held on June 29, brought its Board of Directors, General Members, staff, and special guests together to reflect on the 2021-2022 fiscal year. Out of an abundance of precaution for all those slated to attend, this year's AGM was once again hosted virtually. The AGM began with greetings from Manitoba's Premier, Heather Stefanson, who was unable to join but sent a video message in her absence.

Highlights from the meeting included a positive financial report, a review of events and projects from the past year, and plans for the 2022-2023 fiscal year – a milestone year for Southport as a company. A lot of exciting activity took place at Southport during the 2021-2022 fiscal year despite the challenges that COVID-19 presented. Of note, Runway 13L-31R was successfully rehabilitated and narrowed, the construction of the Four Winds Cultural Centre was completed, and an 11,000-gallon underground fire suppression water tank was installed at Southport Golf Club.

Southport CEO, Peggy May, shared the following regarding current plans to celebrate Southport's 30th Anniversary in 2022, "We're looking forward to hosting a 10km Fun(d) Run on-site in the fall to commemorate 30 years and to raise funds for one of Southport's key partners, the Community Foundation of Portage and District.

Plans are also underway to host a 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration BBQ in the Four Winds Cultural Centre, which will take place alongside the unveiling of a restored CT-134 Musketeer on Centennaire Drive."

It was announced that Doug McLennan would remain Board Chair for the ensuing year and that MNP LLP would continue to be Southport's auditors into the 2022-2023 fiscal year. Southport is also pleased to announce the re-election of Board Members, Dale Lyle and Daniel Bolton, to three-year terms.

During the AGM, Southport Board Chair, Doug McLennan, announced the recipients of the Spirit of Southport Award. This award is presented by the Board of Directors to individuals, organizations, agencies, and/or groups committed diligently and consistently to practicing such values as excellence in standards, transparency, innovation, accountability, integrity, mindful respect, equity, and loyalty to the benefit of all concerned. In recognition of their commitment and collaborative work on establishing the Four Winds Cultural Centre, the Board of Directors presented Darryl Taylor, Consultant, Cornell Pashe, Indigenous Community Coordinator of Portage Community Revitalization Corporation, and Southport's Director, Development, Colby Orchard, the Spirit of Southport Award.



Peggy May shared "Our Board of Directors and Management, supported by a growing team of dedicated employees continue to work toward achieving our annual Strategic Initiatives that contribute to the regional economy. We are proud of Southport's resilience throughout this global pandemic, and we look forward to brighter days ahead celebrating another successful year for Southport."

# **Artist Sponsorship at Fort la Reine Museum**

Tracey is travelling across Canada and the United States creating site-specific art installations at residential school historical sites, cultural centres, museums, art galleries, and other public spaces.

The #HopeAndHealingCanada project is created with crochet, knit, and woven red yarns. This ongoing body of work is used to illustrate connections between Indigenous, Inuit, and Mètis peoples with Canadians, while also addressing the decolonization of public spaces.
