As a Climate Smart certified organization, Southport is proud to launch initiatives around the site creating a greener place to live and work. The four new builds in Centennaire South have been registered with Efficiency Manitoba. Efficiency Manitoba is Manitoba's newest Crown corporation dedicated to Energy Efficiency.

Southport is following and exceeding Efficiency Manitoba's Prescriptive Path which incorporates 10 mandatory energy saving upgrades.

These homes are estimated to be at least 20% more efficient than with traditional building methods.







Southport Runway Construction

Constructed started on the airfield on Monday, August 30, 2021. The ongoing work will be carried out during the week and some weekends.

During this period, there will be a substantial presence of construction traffic on site, the main areas affected will be Centennaire Drive, Anson, and Musketeer Road East.
